Air (slow or lively), March, Jig (Double, Single, Slip Jig), Polka, Slide, Hornpipe, Reel or Set Dance <u>Beginner Solos</u> – intended for musicians 18 years old and under, who are new to their instrument (playing less than 18 months). Competitors will play one tune from any class.

Open Solos – Open to any musician of the appropriate age group.

Under 10- one tune from any class,

U11-U15- play 2 tunes (each from a different music class),

U16 and over – play 3 tunes (each from a different music class)
